

## ANNEX .CZ - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .CZ ccTLD

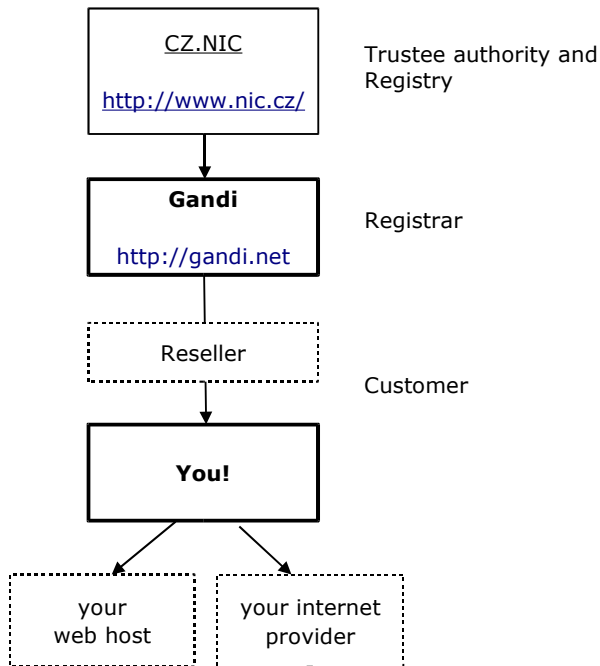

In addition to Gandi's general terms and conditions of domain name registration, the registration and use of a .CZ domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions. Your contracts are also accessible at the address: <http://www.gandi.net/admin/contracts/>.

### Section .CZ.1. Trustee authority and Registry

.CZ is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of Czech Republic.

The following diagram presents the various parties involved and the Trustee Authority for the .CZ TLD:

### Section .CZ.2. Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .CZ domain name, You acknowledge to have fully understood, and You agree to have full knowledge of and to abide by all the rules and specific conditions pertaining to the registration of .CZ domain names, as defined by the Registry CZ.NIC, and which may be viewed at the following addresses:

### Section .CZ.4. Storage and use of personal data

You accept that CZ.NIC can access to Your personal data.

In application of Our contract with CZ.NIC, We have to archive Your personal data for at least 5 years from the end of Your contractual relationship with Us.

### Section .CZ.6. Dispute resolution policy

Provisions of the [Alternative Dispute Resolution Rules](#) state that a third party which thinks that their rights were injured by registration of a domain name may decide to resolve such dispute using a general jurisdiction [court](#), or using the Arbitration Court of the Chamber of Commerce and Agriculture of the Czech Republic. Should such third person decide to use the Arbitration Court of the Chamber of Commerce and Agriculture of the Czech Republic, the domain name holder is obliged to comply with its ruling.

### Section .CZ.7. Transfers

.CZ transfers are possible with an authorization code, which must be requested by the current owner from the current registrar.

The transfer to Gandi does not include any renewal for a .CZ domain name.

A transfer away from Gandi is performed by following the transfer procedure of the Registrar that You have chosen (the gaining registrar). To enable such transfer, You will need to unlock Your domain name on Our Website. We will not charge you any fee for this procedure, as long as You are up-to-date with all payments due for Your domain name when we receive the transfer request from the Registry (domain name not blocked, expired, or having outstanding payments).

### Section .CZ.8. Deletion process

If a domain name is not renewed before the Expiration date, then on the day of Expiration the domain name enters a "protection period" of 45 days.

If the domain name is not renewed during the first 30 days of the protection period, the Registry CZ.NIC may cancel the domain name delegation. In such a case, the domain name can neither be renewed nor modified during the 15 last days of the protection period.
